

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

Total Paid and Incurred by Fiscal Year for Injuries within Fiscal Year





Claim Type by Fiscal Year





Total Paid by Fiscal Year Regardless of Injury Date







## Total Ending Open Inventory





Top 5 Cause of Injury





Top 5 Part of Body Injured





**Top 5 Nature of Injury**




