## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE #13

Week of June 24, 2024

Hi Everyone!

Construction has begun and these updates will be distributed regularly to keep the community up to date on the status of the projects. Thanks in advance for everyone's understanding and patience during construction.

### Current Period

- With demolition and grading completed on the north side of Broadway, the Contractor will start forming and pouring the new curb, gutter, sidewalks, and driveways.
- Contractor's night work operations continue with the installation the new 8-inch water main on Mosquito Road and a new 18-inch sewer on Broadway.
- Contractor's night crew has also been installing new water service lines near Blairs and Broadway to allow for the final tie-in of the new water main and abandonment of the old water main.
- The retaining wall crew is working on some final wall items by installing the brick wall caps, installing a split rail fence above the wall and forming and pouring the steps after the sidewalk has been poured.
- Traffic control measures will be in place to direct vehicles and pedestrians through the work areas, but there may be some minor delays.
- **Businesses near the project site and their access will remain open during all stages of construction.**

### Following Period

- **NIGHT WORK** - To help alleviate traffic congestion near the Broadway and Mosquito Road intersection, the Contractor will continue work operations to install a new 8-inch water main on Mosquito Road and a new 18-inch sewer on Broadway. ***This work will continue for approximately 4 more weeks.***
- **DAY WORK** – Contractor will continue with sidewalk construction work on the north side of Broadway and will start to move over to the south side of Broadway from Blairs to the east with demolition and grading work for the new curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveways, and small retaining walls.

### Important Information

HWY 50 eastbound off-ramp at Broadway and Mosquito Road under HWY 50 will be closed at night due to nighttime work operations at the intersection of Mosquito Road and Broadway.
