CONSTRUCTION UPDATE #17

Week of July 22, 2024

Hi Everyone!

Construction has begun and these updates will be distributed regularly to keep the community up to date on the status of the projects. Thanks in advance for everyone's understanding and patience during construction.

Current Period

- Contractor has started demolition and grading work on the south side of Broadway from Blairs to the
 east for new curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveways and retaining walls Form and pouring should start
 towards the end of the week
- Final water line connections have been made along with installing a few new valves that will help isolate the Broadway water main and minimize impacts to residents and business for any future shutdowns
- Night crew will start at Broadway and Mosquito Road with the installation of the new 8-inch sewer line and manholes that runs down the center of Broadway
- Traffic control measures will be in place to direct vehicles and pedestrians through the work areas, but there may be some minor delays.
- Businesses near the project site and their access will remain open during all stages of construction.

Following Period

- **NIGHT WORK** To help alleviate traffic congestion near the Broadway and Mosquito Road intersection, the Contractor will continue work operations to install the new 18-inch sewer and manholes down the center of Broadway. **This work will continue for approximately 6 more weeks.**
- <u>DAY WORK</u> Contractor has moved over to the south side of Broadway from Blairs to the east and will forming and pouring the new curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveways, and small retaining walls. Once the south side surface improvements are done daytime work will be minimal.

Important Information

HWY 50 eastbound off-ramp at Broadway and Mosquito Road under HWY 50 will be closed at night due to nighttime work operations at the intersection of Mosquito Road and Broadway.
