





INVESTIGATIONS/CRIME REDUCTION TEAM

Investigations 2023 open case load is currently 24. The Crime Reduction Team consists of a sergeant and two detectives to meet the needs of the department and the community.

The daily duties and responsibilities of the CRT varies greatly, but can be summed up as encompassing warrant arrests, case follow-up, rapid response to crime-related tips and self-initiated investigations.

Crime Reduction Team and Investigations – Notable Activity

- 9 Individuals referred to Navigation Center.
- 4 Individuals arrested for active felony warrant, drunk in public, domestic violence, and trespass.
- 5 Individuals cited for drug paraphernalia, possession of switchblade, unlawful camping, and trespass.
- CRT assisted the California State Contractors Board in licensing operation. 8 individuals cited.
