

A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE DECLARING AUGUST 6TH, 2024, AS NATIONAL NIGHT OUT 2024

WHEREAS: The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) is sponsoring a unique,

nationwide "lights on" campaign and celebration against crime, drug, and violence

on August 6th, 2024 entitled, National Night Out; and

WHEREAS: National Night Out provides a unique opportunity for the City of Placerville to join

forces with 38 million people and over 16,000 communities from all fifty states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities, and military bases in promoting cooperative,

police-community crime prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS: The City Council plays a vital role in assisting the Placerville Police Department

through joint crime, drug, and violence prevention efforts in the City of Placerville

and is supporting National Night Out 2024 locally; and

WHEREAS: It is essential that all citizens of the City of Placerville be aware of the importance
