WHEREAS:	While serving on the City Council, Pierre reached new heights while summiting Mount Kilimanjaro in Tanzania in 2007; and
WHEREAS:	A few years after serving his second term on the City Council, the Director of Development Services position became vacant, and Pierre was appointed as the new Director in 2013; and
WHEREAS:	Pierre instilled a strong Customer service culture in the Department and has been a key member of the City's Administrative Team by providing invaluable wisdom and guidance in grappling with issues Citywide; and
WHEREAS:	Under Pierre's servant leadership, the City implemented its first Code Enforcement Division, went live with a new online building permit software, saw the successful development of the Sutter's Ridge Subdivision, Apple Farm Place shopping Center Improvements, secured over \$3 million in State and Federal Grants for the Mallard and Middletown Apartment projects, which are currently under construction; and
WHEREAS:	After 22 years of combined service to the City, Pierre will enjoy more time in the great outdoors, traveling, and creating new memories:
